

Manufacturing Cybersecurity Program



- Grants of up to \$30,000 for cybersecurity capital equipment
- Massachusetts-based small and medium manufacturing pursuing cybersecurity standards such as CMMC, SOC2, or 27001
- Non-profit partner requirement
- 1:1 match

Eligible expenses



Cybersecurity capital equipment, including:

- Badge readers
- Cameras
- Servers
- Network switches
- Security appliances such as firewalls

Does not include:

• Software

Cybersecurity assessment



- Applicants must be pursuing a cybersecurity standard such as CMMC, SOC2, or 27001
- A third-party cybersecurity assessment, conducted within the last 12 months, is required
- Fees incurred to complete the assessment are eligible to be included as part of 1:1 cost share

Non-profit partnership



- All manufacturers need a non-profit partner
- Institutions of higher education, non-profits, or other public or quasi-public entities legally organized in Massachusetts

Funding requests must be for capital cyber equipment

Cost match

- Minimum of 1:1 match is required, cannot come from MA state dollars
- Match can come from a variety of capital and operational expenditures – including equipment, software, and workforce training
- Fees from cybersecurity assessment and non-profit partner can count towards match (if not paid for with MA state dollars)
- Must be incurred within the same year as the project



Preparing our Supply Chain to Compete MMAP

- Supporting our SMEs through capital grants up to \$200K
 - Key industries: Defense and aerospace, semiconductor, battery, and additive manufacturing
 - Adoption of new technologies
 - Progress towards Industry 4.0
 - Commitment to talent development
 - Awarded 39 mfgs to date
